Disha's motto is to work together, to uplift the health status of rural and tribal mass by their own people at their door-step.

There is a huge gap in the field for health services between rural and urban area in our society. Disha Arogya Kutir Darekasa through its various activities since its inception in 1999 trying to deliver the modern health facilities to the rural and tribal population to fill this gap up to certain extent.

At Darekasa, through Disha Arogya Kutir regular OPDs are conducted on every 2nd and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday, with the help of local 9 Arogya doots and 2 Arogya Sevikas, continuous follow-ups, primary and referral health services are being carried out throughout the year.

In last 19 years Disha achieved some remarkable goals substantially:

Providing X-ray, Pathology and Ultra Sonography services in the village, to uplift the health status of tribal mass.

Control Malaria effectively by providing Radical treatment to Tendu patta pluckers during their stay in that area. Similarly local residents are also provided with preventive medicines.

☆ Reduce the number of cases of T.B. DOT Regim treatment provided to the patients.

 $\Rightarrow$  Reduced the rate of infant and maternal mortality.

Conducting educational seminars for adolescent girls to educate them about their health, nutrition and social stigma, experts guide them to protect themselves and to handle the adverse situations cleverly and bravely. Most important task is to treat anaemia with a scientific approach in female population, particularly in puberty age group girls, regular checkup and treatment camps are being conducted for them.

Disha is instrumental in creating awareness, rule out myths regarding Diabetes in the urban and rural areas of Gondia district, by conducting regular Diabetes awareness programme and various check-up camps for diabetics since last 20 years.

 $\Rightarrow$  Ambulance service is being provided by DISHA from 2013.

☆ Young boys and girls of rural areas are voluntarily donating blood regularly.

### ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE YEAR :

6 Children referred by Disha Arogya Kutir Darekasa get successfully operated at Lata Mangeshkar Medical College Nagpur by Dr.Rajendra Saoji & his team of Bal Mitra Foundation.

From this year Dental Checkup & Treatment facilities has been started on 4th Sunday of every month at Disha Arogya Kutir Darekasa by Dr.Mausmi Twiari Sr.Dental Surgeon from Gondia. In this year 64 patients treated.
